

Santa Rosa Teacher of the Year 2014

Your Teacher of the Year is being selected to begin the process toward the 2013 National Teacher of the Year. He/She should be selected based on past performance in the classroom, school and at the district level.

Who is eligible for nomination?

The following full-time district educators in their **fourth** year or more of teaching:
(This school year is included in the four years.)

- Classroom teachers in traditional and charter public schools – Grades Pre K-12
- Adult education teachers
- Postsecondary vocational/technical education teachers
- Department chairpersons who actively engage in classroom teaching
- Guidance counselors
- Media specialists
- Speech/language pathologists
- Special area teachers (i.e. exceptional student education, foreign languages, music, physical education)
- Other professional educators performing instructional support services with students (i.e. school psychologists)

School personnel who work in an administrative or supervisory capacity, such as principals or deans of students, are ineligible.

PLEASE NOTE:

A teacher retiring during or at the end of the 2012-2013 school year, is **not eligible** for 2014 Teacher of the Year due to his/her inability to serve as your school's Teacher of the Year representative during the 2013-2014 school year.
